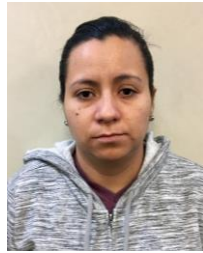

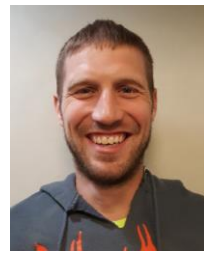

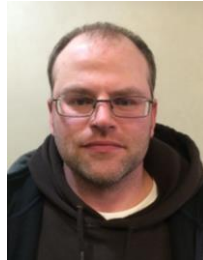

## Silica, Silica, Silica

Silica is a basic component of soil, sand and granite and can be found in some of the products that we use. The best way to prevent diseases from respirable Silica is to minimize our exposure by following **Olympic's Silica Exposure Control Plan**. Here are a few examples: the use of *sweeping compound* when cleaning up our work area, using *HEPA self-cleaning vacuums* when sanding, and utilizing the *2-fan system* in our pump shacks.
