

Olympic Companies, Inc. Site-Specific Safety Plan RE: Covid-19 Virus Response

As we work through these challenging times it's important to Olympic Companies that all workers feel safe on our projects. All employees have been instructed and informed of the following:

- **STAY home if you are not feeling well.** If you are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat you must stay home.
Employees who are not feeling well are required to take their own temperature before leaving home. If their temperature is 100.4 degrees or greater, they will be instructed to stay home. Employees that show up with signs of illness will be directed to leave the project and are not to return to work until 72 hours after all symptoms have passed.
- If an employee or their family member is diagnosed with the COVID-19, our employee is to contact Olympic Companies' Superintendent. Our employee will explain what their situation is, and our Superintendent will then relay this information (in strict confidentiality) to our customer's Project Manager. Our employee will be issued instructions to self-quarantine and seek medical care as per CDC guidelines. Our employee will need to provide a *Return to Work* slip from their treating doctor stating that they are cleared to return to work.
- Disinfectants and cleaning supplies are being mobilized to our projects to keep break areas and "shared" surfaces clean. (workstations, "shared" tools, lunchroom tables, etc.)
- Signage, toolbox talks and updates from the office will be communicated in the field to remind crews of keeping hands clean and away from your face, proper hygiene, and the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 Virus as advised by the CDC.
- To maintain social distancing (*6 feet apart*); the number of employees in breakrooms, job site meetings, freight elevators/skip hoists, and the scheduling of work activities will be monitored.
- Continue the proper use of PPE (safety glasses and gloves, etc.) as these are also a defense against communicable diseases.

With continuous communication, the monitoring of our projects, and the availability to answer questions to the best of our abilities; we together, can prevent the spread of the Covid-19 Virus, and maintaining a safe and healthy workplace.
