OSHA & GHS Training

I have heard from other Safety Directors in town that OSHA Inspectors are asking workers if they know what GHS is & has your employer trained you?

The answer is: GHS stands for Global Harmonization Systems. Yes we have been trained, Olympic trained their crews in the fall of 2013. You received a laminated card for your wallet with sample Pictograms and we had refresher training in our 2014 Right-To-Know.

Other questions were: **What is a SDS?** (Safety Data Sheets replacing the MSDS)

Last week's Bonus Question: **What signage should Olympic foreman post for your work activity?**

Answer: **Signage depends on the activity that we are performing. Here are a few examples:**

Carpenters: HILTI & Laser signage, fall protection needed. **Tapers:** Finished walls, Medical clinic maps.

Scaffold Crew: Scaffold not completed, Scaffold Agreement needed, **Fire proofers:** Slippery when wet, high pressure hoses. **Spray Foam crew:** Controlled Access, No Hot Work in this area.

Inspect your equipment (*scaffold, aerial lifts, ladders, fall protection, electrical cords, etc., etc.*) prior to the start of each work shift.
