Carbon Monoxide

Cold weather is here. GC's are getting prepared by ordering temp heaters, running propane lines and Olympic is starting to poly in our scaffolds. We need to be prepared for possible carbon monoxide exposures on our jobsites.

What is Carbon Monoxide? What are the signs of over exposure? How do we protect ourselves?

Attached to this T-B-T are answers to these questions. Review this information with crew and answer any questions. On the backside of this sheet is a sample inspection form that will be issued and monitored by our Supts. This form will need to be completed periodically if we have temp heaters running on our jobsites to ensure safe air quality.

Report any safety hazards to your Foreman.

Last week's Bonus Question: How many crew members on this jobsite are certified in First Aid & CPR?

Answer: Answers vary depending on jobsite crew.

Inspect your equipment (*scaffold, aerial lifts, ladders, fall protection, electrical cords, etc., etc.*) prior to the start of each work shift.
