Hint: **See Foreman**

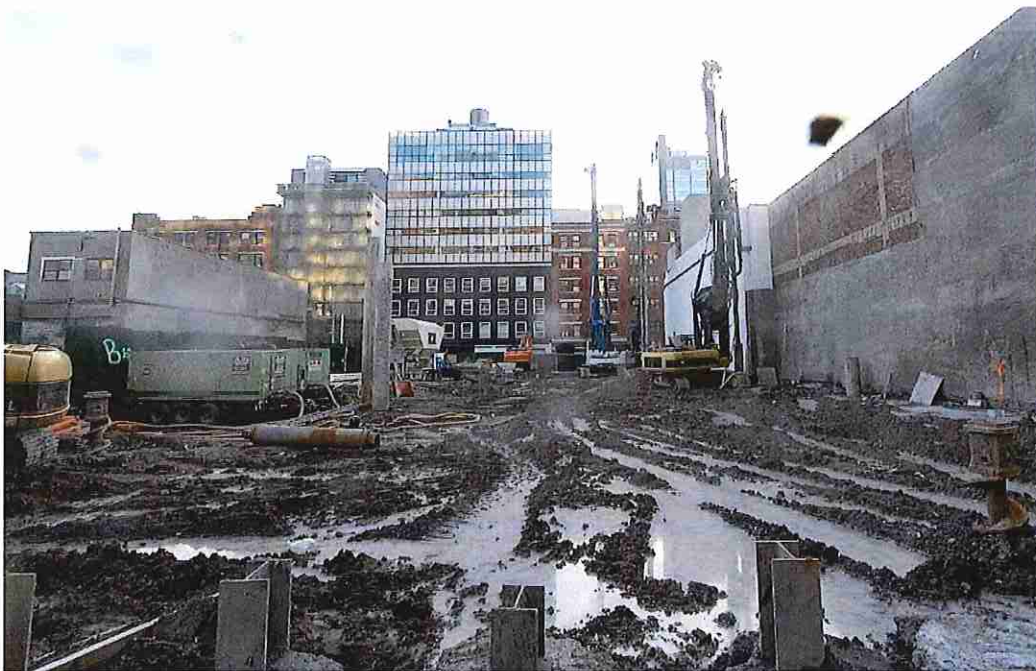


## SPRING IS HERE
