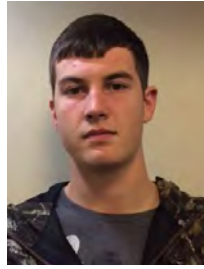

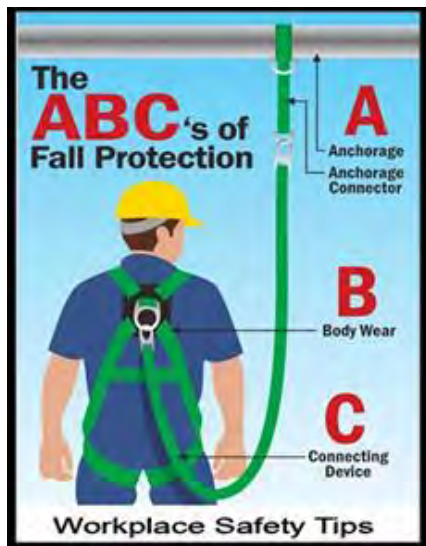

Fall Protection

During our work day we run across situations where we need to address fall protection. The exposure to a fall may vary; from working near the edge of a building, slip/trips exposure, working on a ladder, and working near another trade that has removed a hole cover. As these situations come up, we ask ourselves, "Do I need fall protection? Where do I tie off to? What type of fall protection will work the best?" Each of us needs to look ahead of where we are going to be in the next couple of days so we can create a plan.

This week we participated in National Safety STAND-DOWN "TO PREVENT FALLS IN CONSTRUCTION". The Safety Committee is looking forward to reviewing & discussing the information obtained and shared by each crew.
