N95 respirators / 3 PLY Disposable Face Masks

As we see in the media, the N95 masks that we use when we are sanding, insulating and fireproofing, are now being used by medical providers & first responders. This makes it more difficult for our suppliers to get us as many as we need. A few weeks ago we sent out a TBT discussing how we can extend the life of the N95 respirators we are using. We are doing a great job with our 6' social distancing, but there are times we need to work with a partner or may have another trade working near by. That being said, we need to use the correct respiratory protection for the activity we are performing. If we are sanding, insulating, fireproofing or in areas where dust levels are high we need to use the N95 Respirator. If we are working where we are unable to practice our 6' social distancing we need to use the 3 PLY Disposable Mask. If you have any questions &/or concerns, talk to your Foreman, Dan Nestrud, Jeff Manick or Sturg.

N95 Respirators / 3 PLY Disposable Face Masks



When we are exposed to dust that can harm us, please use the N95 respirators.



When we are unable to practice "social distancing" and need to work closer than 6' to one another, we need to wear the 3 PLY disposable masks.



Due to the large demand and limited supply of disposable paper respirators, we reached out to our manufacture to see what we can do to extend the life of our respirators.



After using the respirator, let it dry in a clean area on our jobsite.



Give the respirator a *slight tap* to remove excess debris on the outside of the mask.



Write your name on a "paper" bag and place the respirator inside the bag.



Place the individual bags in a container for safe storage until needed the next day.
