COVID-19 Virus PPE Update

Olympic & our GC's have updated our lists of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) that we are required to use when working on our projects. On many of our projects we are being directed when working within 6 feet of a co-worker, that these two workers wear a mask. We have other GC's requiring us to wear masks 100% of the time we are working on their jobsite. The use of a mask may not be comfortable, but is necessary to help prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Last week's Bonus Question: What are 2 possible symptoms of over exposure to the chemical inside a fire extinguisher?

Answer: Symptoms may include: headache, shortness of breath, sweating, dizziness, tingling in the arms & legs or unconsciousness.

Inspect your equipment (*scaffold, aerial lifts, ladders, fall protection, electrical cords, etc., etc.*) prior to the start of each work shift.

Personal Protective Equipment Changes

In the past, Olympic crews have used hardhats, eye protection, Hi-V vest and hearing protection as our standard PPE. In the last month, that has changed. To prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus, Olympic and our General Contractors, have put programs in place to help prevent the spread of this virus. We now have projects where our PPE requires us to wear masks either 100% of the day and or when we are working within 6' of a co-worker.

Additionally, some of our projects have a pre-screening form and temperature testing that is to be completed before we start work. This additional precaution is being put into place so that you and I do not get the virus or spread it to another co-worker. These forms need to be filled out accurately. If someone in your household has a sore throat, a cough, fever or has tested for COVID-19, please notify your Foreman.
