## Working and Walking Surfaces

With the winter weather we have been experiencing this season, one day it's 35 degrees and the next it drops to below zero, potentially causing some slip/fall issues on our projects. We may have some slippery areas where one of our crew members could slip and fall. We need to address these areas with our GC to abate the fall potential. If the GC does not address the issue, our foreman will order up sand from our vendors to make this problem go away.

**Saying nothing to prevent someone from getting hurt is NOT acceptable!**

**Last week's Bonus Question:** Are the sidewalks into the building or by our houses slippery?  
What should we do about that safety issue?

**Answer:** If we have slippery conditions on our jobsite, notify the GC Supt to address the safety concern. If they fail to abate the problem, we need to take care of it ourselves. Couple bags of sand is a lot cheaper than the cost of one of our employees making a trip to the clinic.

Inspect your equipment (*scaffold, aerial lifts, ladders, fall protection, electrical cords, etc., etc..*) prior to the start of each work shift.
