We are having more and more GC's require "ANSI rated" safety glasses and this includes those of us that need prescription eyewear. As of today, if you do not have rated safety glasses, notify your foreman that you need an **OVER-SIZED** goggle or glasses to fit over your current pair of glasses. These **OVER-SIZED** glasses will be required until you make arrangements for ANSI rated glasses. These can be purchased at various optical clinics or contact Lindsey for information on Olympic's Safety Glasses Program.

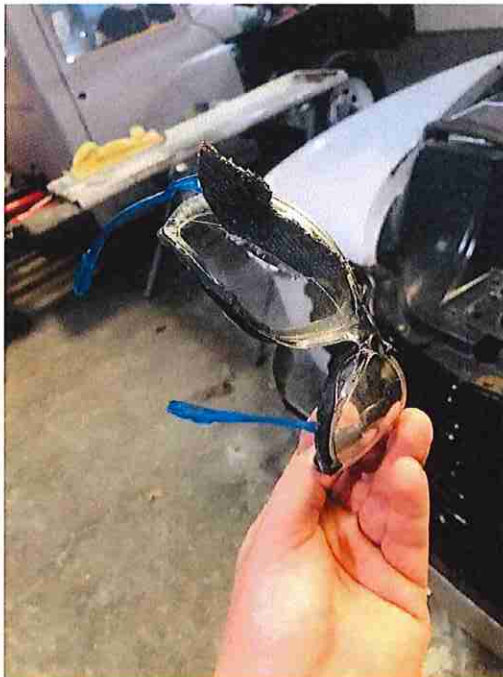

TO: Olympic Employees
RE: Prescription Glasses

It was brought to the attention of our Safety Committee, that four of our General Contractors are requiring our employees that wear prescription glasses to be ANSI Z-87 approved frames, safety rated glass & side shields, or they will need to wear oversized safety glasses or goggles over their current non-rated safety glasses.

Olympic Companies requests that all employees who currently wear "prescription eyewear" be adequately protected by an ANSI approved Z87 eyewear, or request the over-sized goggles or glasses from the warehouse.

To help this along, Olympic has made arrangements with Walman Optical to provide us their optical services. Walman Optical works with designated clinics throughout the state supplying a large variety of safety rated eyewear at a discounted price.

If you need this service please contact Lindsey @ (612) 599-1107 for a catalog list of clinics and an order form.

The Safety Committee has agreed to pay the first \$75.00 for each prescription for a one-year period of time. Walman Optical has many styles of glasses in this price range that include frames and lenses. They have frames and lens that start at \$75.00 and can go up to \$350.00 depending on the style & your prescription. If the glasses you choose are over the \$75.00 limit, you will be asked to pay the difference by submitting the outstanding balance to your health insurance.

If you wish to purchase your ANSI rated glasses through another vendor, you are welcome to do so. Bring in your sales slip and we will reimburse you up to \$75.00 dollars.
