Winter Housekeeping

We got a little taste of upcoming winter conditions last week. The BIG snow won't hold off forever, so it's time to start preparing for it's arrival. If we have materials stored outside, move them to a location where they will not get damaged by snow plows or other heavy equipment. If poly is used to cover these materials, make sure any excess poly is tucked in so that nobody steps on it causing them to slip and fall. Sidewalks and other entrances to the building can become snow packed and slippery. Request that the GC's Supt. uses salt/sand to provide traction.

Scaffold that **has not** been bagged; working levels and stairways need to be cleaned off prior to use. Scaffold that **has** been bagged; top level needs to be fully decked to prevent snow / ice build up.

Last week's Bonus Question: Do we have exposure to carbon monoxide on this work site?
If so, what can we do to protect ourselves?

Answer: Answers varied by project. At some jobsites the GC has people with air monitors and at other jobsites they do not. Olympic has CO2 Monitoring Sheets available for us to use.
